Garnet Menger Award

Established in 1990 in memory of the noted musician and teacher, Garnet Menger, this award is given annually to an outstanding student in any Department of Music program.

The award acknowledges and rewards accomplishment in academic, artistic, and student life activities.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants must be studying full-time or part-time and enrolled in the Department of Music
- This award is open to Undergraduate and Graduate students.
- Only Canadian Citizens and Permanent Residents are eligible.

Award Value: \$2,500.00

How to Apply:

Qualified candidates must submit, along with their application form:

- Two letters of reference from full- or part-time faculty in the Department of Music.
- A brief essay (500 words) detailing their academic and artistic accomplishments in the area of Music, and involvement in student life activities.
